2. ADMISSION FOR NRI SEATS WILL BE ADEVERTISED SEPARATELY. THE CANDIDATES FOR NRI SEATS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO APPEAR IN THE ENTRANCETEST.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

1. A candidate will be eligible for appearing in the Entrance Test for MDS Course if he/she
 - i) is a citizen of India.
 - ii) has passed BDS examination from any Dental College/Institution recognized by the Dental Council of India/Govt. of India.
 - iii) has completed satisfactorily or is liable to complete one year compulsory rotating internship by 15.5.2009 from colleges recognized by the Dental Council of India.
 - iv) Is registered with the State Dental Council/DCI at the time of admission.
 - v) Possesses a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the Institution last attended.
2. The candidate will have to submit the above-mentioned certificates, except the certificate at Sr. No. (iii) and (iv) above, in original at the time of counselling without which the admission shall not be granted. The certificates of completion of internship and registration at Sr. No.(iii) & (iv) mentioned above will have to be submitted by **20.5.2009** positively, failing which their Provisional Admission will stand cancelled without any further notice.
3. A candidate who is already admitted to a course in any institution is eligible to apply for another course only after passing the first course. An undertaking to this effect will be obtained from the candidate. Concealment of facts would invite disqualification.
4. After commencement of the MDS Course if a candidate having joined the course leaves it before completion of full period :
 - i). he/she will be debarred for next three years from applying for admission to any P.G. Course (Degree/Diploma) in the M.M. College of Dental Sciences & Research, Mullana (Ambala).
 - ii) he/she will have to execute a Bond for payment of One Year's full fee of MDS degree Course, at the time of admission.
5. Candidates already in service must submit their Application Form through their employer or produce 'No Objection Certificate', from their employer on or before the last date fixed for receipt of Application Form.

DURATION OF MDS COURSE

The period of training for obtaining MDS degree shall be three academic years including the period of examination.

The candidates shifting from one subject to another or joining the course from waiting list within one month from the starting of the session (closing date of admission) will be permitted to take the examination along with the regular batch. On the other hand, the period of absence (even less than 30 days) due to any reasons, after the closing date of admission i.e. 30 days from the start of session shall not be condoned.

DOCUMENTS TO BE ENCLOSED WITH THE APPLICATION FORM

The following documents/attested copies must be enclosed alongwith the filled in Application Form :-

- a) Certificate of passing B.D.S. examination from an Institution recognized by the DCI/Government of India.
- b) Four copies of recent photograph (passport size) duly attested by the Director/Principal of the College/Gazetted Officer or the employer in case of those in employment.
- c) Internship Completion Certificate certifying the date on which the candidate completed / is liable to complete one year compulsory rotating internship. The date of completion of internship should not be beyond 15.5.2009.
- d) Certificate of good conduct from Head of the Institution last attended.
- e) Proof that the dental college from which the candidate has passed BDS Examination is recognized by DCI. The Certificate should be signed by the Head of the Institution from which the candidate has graduated. In the absence of this certificate admission shall not be granted.
- f) Certificate of Registration with the State Dental Council/DCI at the time of admission.

The original documents will have to be submitted at the time of Counselling with the exception of the certificate (c) and (f) above which will have to be submitted by **20-5-2009** positively failing which their provisional Admission will stand cancelled without any further notice.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The Application Form duly completed in candidate's own handwriting, should reach the Admission Office of the University at M.M. College of Dental Sciences & Research, Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Mullana - Ambala (Haryana), 133-203 on or before **23.02.2009 by 4:00 P.M.** It may be delivered either personally or sent under registered cover. Candidates already in employment should send their application through proper channel. Incomplete Application Form or received after the closing date/time will not be considered. Neither the competent Authority takes any responsibility for any postal delay in the receipt or loss of Application Form or any document/correspondence in transit nor any intimation with regard to rejection of the candidature on account of the late receipt of Application Form will be sent to such candidates.

General Information :

1. The cost of Prospectus-cum-Application Form will not be refunded under any circumstances.
2. Any attempt on the part of a candidate, parents or relatives to canvass or bring influence to bear upon the Competent Authority, directly or indirectly, for securing admission will lead to disqualification.
3. The candidate is admitted on the basis of information submitted by him/her and if, at any subsequent stage, it is discovered that any portion of this information is incorrect, the student will be removed from the institution and all fees and other dues paid/liable to be paid up till the date of such removal shall be forfeited/ charged. Any further action as deemed suitable may also be taken by the University against such student.
4. The Application Form should be filled in carefully in block and legible letters and signed by the candidate. All claims made in the application must be supported with documentary proof. Applications which are incomplete in respect of the required particulars or due to lack of essential documents will be rejected.
5. In case of any ambiguity in the rules, the interpretation by the Vice-Chancellor/Competent Authority of the University shall be final.
- 6.. A student who violates the above conditions willfully or otherwise shall be liable to expulsion.
7. Instructions/directions to modify/change the conditions can be issued by the University prior to counselling.
8. Objections, if any, about the entries/conditions of eligibility mentioned in the prospectus can be raised in the form of a representation to the Competent Authority before the start of counselling.

SCHEME OF TEST

1. The Test will be held on **Sunday, 08-03-2009** from **2.00 P.M. to 3.30 P.M.** at Examination Hall, M.M. University, Mullana (Ambala).
2. **As per conditions, the candidates who secure less than 50% marks in the Entrance Test shall not be eligible for admission to the MDS Course on the basis of the result of this Entrance Test.**
 - i) The Test will consist of one paper of **360** marks carrying multiple choice questions;
 - ii) Duration of paper : One hour and thirty minutes (**2.00 P.M. to 3.30 P.M.**)
 - iii) Number of questions (items): **120**
 - iv) The Test is of objective type - The candidates will be provided with a sealed Test Booklet containing an answer-sheet. The seal will be broken open by the candidate on the announcement by the invigilator and not before that. The test booklet will contain **120** MCQs of best response type. The candidates are required to carefully read the instruction sheet on the question booklet before attempting. The method of marking responses will be clearly indicated on the instruction sheet. No deviation other than the method prescribed will be considered.
4. **WRITING OF PARTICULARS**

The candidate must fill up the required particulars including his Roll No., Centre of Examination, Test Booklet Number, **Series Number and Signature on the OMR/answer** sheet in the appropriate boxes. He/she must NOT write his/her Roll No. anywhere else on the answer-sheet.
5. **MARKING OF ANSWER SHEET**

Three marks (3) will be given for each correct answer and one mark (-1) will be deducted for each wrong answer.
6. **PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN THE EXAMINATION HALL.**
 - a) Each candidate will be given a sealed Test Booklet with an answer-sheet placed inside it.
 - b) Immediately on receipt of the Test Booklet as well as the answer sheet, the candidate will first read the instructions on it and fill in the required particulars on cover page of the Test Booklet and on the OMR answer sheet. Before attempting the question paper, the Candidate must check that the Test Booklet supplied to him/her is complete in all respects as regards the number of pages with 120 questions and OMR sheet. Discrepancy, if any, should be brought to the notice of the invigilator immediately and the Booklet should be got changed. No complaint in this regard will be entertained 30 minutes after the start of the test.
 - c) The test will start exactly at the time mentioned in the Prospectus and an announcement to this effect will be made by the invigilator. No candidate will be allowed entry in the Examination Hall 15 minutes after the commencement of the test.
 - d) During the examination, the invigilator will check the Admit-Cards and compare the photograph of each candidate to satisfy himself about the genuineness of the candidate. The rubber stamp of the Centre Superintendent will be affixed on the space provided in the Answer-Sheet and the test booklet. Each candidate shall also be required to sign the attendance sheet.
 - e) After completing the test and before handing over the Test Booklet and Answer Sheet, the candidate should check again that he/she has followed the instructions printed on the test-booklet and that all the particulars have been written correctly. He/she must ensure that the Roll No. is written correctly in the OMR/Answer-Sheet.

- f) A signal will be given both at the beginning and end of the Test. At the closing signal the candidate must stop marking responses.
- g) The OMR Answer-Sheet should be handled by the candidate very carefully, it should not be folded or mutilated in any manner, to ensure complete and accurate evaluation of the Answer-Sheet.
- h) To answer any question, the candidate will be required to darken the circle by using **black ball point pen only** corresponding to the answer, he/she thinks to be correct. An example for the same is given here under serial no. i.
- i) Question : When a tuning fork vibrates with 1.0m or 1.05m long wire of a conomoter, 5 beats per second are produced in each case. What will be the frequency of the tuning fork?

- j) The test booklet and the OMR Answer Sheet must be handed over to the invigilator before leaving the hall, failing which the candidature of the candidate will stand cancelled.
- i) There will be no reevaluation/rechecking of the OMR Answer Sheet.

7 LEGAL JURISDICTION

All disputes relating to admission of students, refund of fee, etc. will be subject to Ambala Courts or Courts having jurisdiction in Ambala only.

SYLLABUS FOR ENTRANCE TEST - MDS COURSE

Syllabus of BDS examinations in various subjects as prescribed by the Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Mullana/Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak/Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and duly recognized by the DCI will form the basis of the Entrance Test. The questions will cover the entire syllabus of the BDS course.

METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION

The candidates called for counselling will be required to produce all original documents/certificates/marks sheet, etc. at the time of counselling. Under no circumstances, any relaxation will be allowed to the candidates as regards appearing in person before the Board on the fixed date and time and producing the requisite original documents/certificates/marks sheet, etc.

The candidates will be called for counselling before the Board according to their respective merit and they will be entitled to exercise their choice regarding the subject. Selection of the subject will be according to the availability of the seat(s) at their respective merit at the time of counselling.

NOTE : If two or more candidates secure identical marks in entrance test, their relative merit will be determined by the marks obtained by them in final Professional Examination of BDS. In case the marks in the final Professional Examination of BDS are also identical, the candidate senior in age will get preference.

OTHER CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

On receiving unsatisfactory report about any student from his/her Supervisor and the Head of Department during the course, the admission is liable to be cancelled.

Admission will also be subject to the following conditions:

1. Students coming from Universities other than Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Mullana will be required to deposit migration certificate and all other original certificates immediately after the start of the session.
2. The candidates will be required to pay the fees and other dues etc. as prescribed from time to time, well in time.
3. A candidate can be fined, suspended or expelled from the College/Hostel by the Principal/Director for reasons like indiscipline/misconduct, absence from classes/duties, non-payment of College/Hostel dues in time and use of unauthorized electrical/electronic appliances, etc. The quantum of punishment, mode of taking disciplinary action against such students enquiry etc. will be decided by the concerned Principal/Director/Head of the Department/Chief Warden.
4. No student, after joining the MDS course will be allowed to apply for/accept any appointment (including Senior Residency/Demonstratorship) till the completion of the course.
5. If a student absents himself/herself from duty, an intimation to this effect will be sent by the concerned Head of the Department to the Principal/Director within 48 hours. If the period of absence exceeds 2 days, the Head of the Department/Unit, shall not allow any such student to join his/her duty without prior permission of the Director/Principal.
6. The candidates selected for admission to MDS Degree course will be required to give an affidavit to the effect that they are not undergoing any training at any other Institution and will not appear in All India Entrance Test/Examination of MD/MS/PG Diploma/MDS Entrance Examination of Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak/Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra to be held during the course of their studies in this Institution till the completion of the course. If a candidate is found appearing in any such examination under any circumstances, his/her admission shall be cancelled and will be liable to pay the fee for the remaining period of the course. The Registrar of the University/Principal of the College will be competent authority to recover the balance fee of the remaining period.
7. If a student remains absent continuously for two weeks or a total of six weeks in one year (without getting leave sanctioned), his/her admission shall stand cancelled. For reasons like illness, certificate (upto four weeks continuous or with breaks) issued only by the Director, PG Studies/Principal will be accepted. If a candidate leaves the station with permission and falls ill, a certificate (upto four weeks continuous or with breaks) issued by a Medical Officer not below the rank of Civil Surgeon or Medical Superintendent of the Institution, will only be accepted. The certificates must bear identity (specimen signature) of the candidate, department's despatch No., office stamp and signatures of Head of Deptt./Unit/Civil Surgeon concerned. Certificate on simple OPD card or prescription slip will not be treated as Medical Certificate. For medical leave beyond four weeks, the candidate will have to apply and appear before a Medical Board to be constituted by the Principal. M.M. Medical College, Mullana. Only the Medical Certificate issued by the

Medical Board will be accepted. However, the period of such leave sanctioned will have to be compensated by undergoing training for the extended period equal to the period of leave availed before appearing in the examination and no stipend will be paid for this extended period. If a candidate fails to appear before the Medical Board, his/her admission shall be cancelled without any further notice. Further, if a candidate leaves the country during his/her course without the permission of competent authority, his/her admission shall also be cancelled without any further notice.

8. In case a student avails maternity leave during the course, the same will be allowed as per DCI instructions.
9. The students will be allowed leave as per University/College instructions from time to time.
10. The Head of the Department is competent to sanction leave including station leave upto four days only. If the duration of leave including station leave is more than four days, then the Head of Dept. will forward the application with specific comments to the Director for sanction. Yearly leave will be granted in proportion to the time of the year elapsed.
11. No candidate will be allowed under any circumstances to change the subject/discipline after the final Counselling.

Agreement Bond

Each candidate will be required to execute a bond with two sureties (on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 15/- duly attested by the 1st Class Magistrate) at the time of admission to the effect that he/she will not leave the course before it is completed. In case, anyone leaves the course midway, he/she will execute a bond for the payment of one year fee to the Principal, MMCD SR, Mullana. The institution will have the right to recover such money from the defaulters in accordance with the law of the land. He/she will also be debarred from appearing in the entrance test for the next three years. The proforma of the agreement is available in the Admission Office of the Maharishi Markandeshwar University.

HOW TO FILL IN THE APPLICATION FORM

- i) A candidate seeking admission to the MDS course is required to send his/her application on the prescribed form appended in the prospectus.
- ii) Before filling up the Application Form, the candidate must familiarize himself /herself with the information given in this prospectus and should ensure his/her eligibility before appearing in the Examination Test. The candidate is required to go through the prospectus carefully and acquaint himself/herself with all the requirements with regard to the filling-in of the Application Form.
- iii) Application Form should be filled-in in English only.
- iv) The candidate shall fill-in the Application Form in his/her own handwriting in block letters written neatly and legibly with blue/black ink within the prescribed boxes.
- v) Overwriting/cutting/erasing in the Application Form may lead to rejection of the Application which should be avoided. Any error arising on this account shall be the responsibility of the candidate. (It is advisable to first fill in a photocopy of the form and then the main document.)
- vi) The candidate should write his/her complete address in the Application Form for further correspondence. Pin Code should be given in the space provided for Pin-Code. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that he/she gives his/her correct address. The University or the College shall not be held responsible for any loss or delay of any communication in transit on account of an incorrect address given by the applicant.

- vii) Application Form duly completed must be accompanied by one self addressed stamped envelopes (9" x 4")with postal stamps of Rs.25/- affixed on the envelope.
- viii) The last date for receipt of Application Forms duly completed in all respects is **23.02.2009** by **4:00 P.M.** No grace period will be allowed. Application Forms received after the last date fixed for receipt of Application Form shall not be entertained. Neither the cost of the Application Form nor the amount sent in lieu of the downloaded form will be refunded in any case. No intimation to the candidates whose applications are received late will be sent by the University.
- ix) Candidate should write his/her name, father's name in capital letters as given in Matriculation/High School Certificate of the Board. Only one letter should, be written in one box. One box should be left blank between each part of the name.
- x) **Date of Birth** : Enter the date, month and year of birth as per English calendar and as recorded in the High School/I.C.S.E./Class X or its equivalent Certificate.
(Use Numerals 01 to 31 for days, 01 to 12 for months and last two digits for the year of birth as shown below.)

- xi) **Photograph** : Affix a recent (not taken before 01/01/2009) high contrast photograph (preferably black and white) in the space earmarked for it on the Application Form. Accessories like caps, hats or dark spectacles are not permitted in the photograph. Polaroid camera photos are not acceptable. The photograph should not be defaced. The photograph should be firmly affixed to the Application Form with adhesive (gum/fevicol) and should not be pinned or stapled. Applicants not complying with these instructions or with unclear photograph are liable to be rejected.
- xii) Candidates are requested to put their signature in the box given at the bottom of the space for Photograph. Writing full name in this box in Capital letters would not be accepted as signature and the Application Form is liable to be rejected.
- xiii) Candidate should firmly tie or staple the Application Form and enclosures. Use the envelope provided for despatch of Application Form.
- xiv) Request for change in any particulars in the Application Form shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- xv) Incomplete Application Forms or Forms having over-writing will be rejected.
- xvi) Every candidate is required to submit only one Application Form. If a candidate submits more than one Application Form, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled.
- xvii) The Application Form must be accompanied by:
- Attested photocopy of Matriculation/High School/ICSE/Class-X or its equivalent certificate as proof of date of birth.
 - Attested photocopies of the mark sheets of the qualifying examination (1st to 4th year of BDS)
 - Attested photocopies of BDS degree certificate from a recognized Board/University.
 - Attested photocopy of certificate of registration with State Dental Council / D.C.I.
 - Attested photocopy of character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
 - Attested copy of Internship Completion Certificate.

- xviii) Furnishing of false information or suppression of any information would disqualify the candidate from the entrance test and cancellation of admission if already admitted. If considered necessary, legal action may also be taken against such a candidate.
- xix) **Admit Card** : The candidates will fill in three Admit Cards each annexed to the Application Forms. The Original will be sent to them by Speed Post/Courier. If the same does not reach them in time, they can collect their Duplicate Admit Cards from the Examination Centre specified in the prospectus in the morning of **08.03.2009** (from 9AM to 12 noon) The Admit Card will bear the candidate's roll number, examination centre, candidate's name, father's name, photograph and signature. The candidate should carefully examine the Admit Card received by him/her for all the entries made therein. In case of any discrepancy, the candidate should immediately inform the Registrar of the University.

The annual tuition fee payable by the students of the MDS Course is Rs. 5,44,000/-.

If at any stage, it is discovered that any portion of the information submitted by a candidate, on the basis of which his admission has been allowed, is incorrect or false he/she shall be removed from the College and fee and other dues paid until the date of such removal shall be forfeited. The Institute will also be within its right to take any further action against the student and his/her guardian as it may deemed fit.
14. The selection for admission will be treated as cancelled, if the selected candidate does not join the College on the stipulated date fixed by the Counselling Board.
15. If any candidate or his/her parents or guardian are found to have submitted any false affidavit/certificate, not only the candidate's admission will be cancelled but the person filing such affidavit/document will also be liable to be prosecuted in accordance with Law.

22. In case of any ambiguity in the rules, interpretation of the same as given by the Vice-Chancellor shall be final.

BAN ON RAGGING IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

Instructions for curbing ragging :

Ragging in educational institutions is banned and any one indulging in ragging is likely to be punished appropriately, which punishment may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology. The punishment may also take shape of (i) withholding scholarships or other benefits (ii) suspension or expulsion from hostel and/or mess and the like. If the individuals committing or abetting ragging are not/cannot be identified, collective punishment can be awarded to act as a deterrent.

The following will be termed as the Act of Ragging:

Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in freshers or junior students or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such students will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.
