ABOUT THE MM (DEEMED TO BE UNIVERSITY)

Ideally located on the 'tapobhoomi' of Maharishi Markandeshwar in the river bed of the sacred Markanda, with exotic lush green rural surroundings, the NAAC Accredited with Grade 'A' this Maharishi Markandeshwar (Deemed to be University), Mullana-Ambala, was established under the aegis of the reputed Maharishi Markandeshwar Education Trust, now known as Maharishi Markandeshwar University. MEDLARS is accessible to all users in the disciplines of Medical Sciences.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

The proposed Entrance Test will be of an all India character and candidates not only from Haryana but also from other states of the country as well as Foreign Nationals/NRIs are eligible to appear in this Entrance Test provided they fulfil the eligibility criteria for admission to M.Sc. Nursing Course as per the rules and regulations of the Indian Nursing Council and the MM(DU).

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

The candidates should fulfil the following minimum conditions to become eligible for admission to M. Sc Nursing course

1. Should be a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
2. Passed B.Sc Nursing/B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% marks in aggregate from an institution recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
3. Minimum one year of work experience after Post Basic/B.Sc Nursing as on **31.10.2018**.

OR

Minimum one year of work experience prior to or after Post Basic B. Sc Nursing as on **31.10.2018**.

4. **SC/ST** candidates will be eligible for relaxation of **5%** marks in eligibility conditions.
5. Candidate should be medically fit *.

*Selected Candidates for M. Sc. Nursing must produce a **Medical Fitness Certificate** from a Medical Board constituted/approved by the Principal, MM College of Nursing, Mullana. The candidature of a candidate found medically unfit is liable to be cancelled. The candidate who fails to attend the medical examination on the notified date shall forfeit the claim for admission as well as placement in the waiting list.

- Note:**
1. Admission to M. Sc. Nursing will be provisional subject to verification of eligibility and registration by the MM(DU).
 2. The list of fake Universities is available in the Academic Branch of the MM(DU) which may be consulted before making Application for admission to the course.

SCHEME OF ENTRANCE TEST

- A) **Date of Entrance Test** **01-07-2018**
Timing 11.00 A.M. to 12:30 P.M.
- B) **Medium of Entrance Test** ENGLISH
- C) **Scheme of Entrance Test**

The Entrance Test will consist of one paper of **1 hour 30 minutes** duration. There will be a total number of **120 objective Type Questions** which will carry maximum of **360 marks** i.e **three marks** for each question. The candidates will have to secure at least **50% qualifying marks** in the Entrance Test to become eligible for appearing before the Counselling Board.

- D) **Syllabi**
The **Entrance Test will be based on the syllabi of B.Sc. Nursing** prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council. **Areas included** in the selection test are **Applied, Physical and Biological Sciences, Nutrition, Social Science, Medical- Surgical, Obstetrical and Gynaecological, Child Health, Mental Health** and **Community Health Nursing and Basic Concepts of Education, Administration, Research and Statistics.**

Note:

1. All the candidates will be allowed provisionally to appear in the Entrance Test. Admission shall be **subject to eligibility/verification** of documents/certificates at the time of counselling and final registration by the MM(DU).
2. The candidates are required to furnish the **Admit Cards** at the time of :
 - (i) Entry into the Examination Hall
 - (ii) During the course of examination for necessary identification by the supervisory staff on duty.
 - (iii) Appearing for counselling before the Counselling Board.The candidates are, therefore, advised to keep their **Admit Cards** intact with them.
3. There will be no reevaluation or rechecking of the Answer Sheet.
4. If any candidate is found guilty of any breach of rules mentioned in the Prospectus or guilty of using unfair means or who is impersonated or is involved in impersonation his/her candidature will be liable to be cancelled apart from such other action as may be deemed fit by the Competent Authority.
5. All disputes pertaining to the conduct of examination and allotment of seat shall fall within the jurisdiction of Ambala courts or courts having jurisdiction in Ambala.
6. If two or more candidates secure identical marks in the entrance test, their relative merit will be determined by the marks obtained by them in the qualifying examination. In case the marks in the qualifying examination are also identical, the candidate senior in age will get preference.

FEE STRUCTURE

1. The Fee will have to be deposited at the time of Counselling.
2. Student fund is charged @ Rs 2000 /- p.a
3. University charges will be extra as per deemed to be University norms.
4. Life time Alumni membership fee Rs. 4000/-.
5. There will be an annual increase of 7% in the tuition fees.
6. Hostel Fee & Transport Charges will be extra.
7. **Refund of Fee admissible under the rules will be made with a deduction of fee as under:**
 - a) In case the student informs of his intention not to join the institution at least 7 days before the start of the academic session, then 100% of the fees collected minus the processing charges, which shall not be more than Rs. 10000/-, or any other amount fixed by UGC will be refunded.
 - b) In case no such information is given by the student but the Institution is able to fill up the seat so vacated, then 100% of the fees collected minus the processing charges, which shall not be more than Rs. 10000/-, or any other amount fixed by UGC will be refunded. The refund shall be affected within 15 days of request from the student or the expiry of 30 days after opening of academic session, whichever is later.
 - c) In case no such information is given by the student and the Institution is not able to fill up the seat even by the end of 30 days after the opening of academic session, then 50% of the fees collected minus the processing charges, which shall not be more than Rs. 10000/-, or any other amount fixed by UGC, the same shall be refunded within 15 days of request of refund from the student or the expiry of 30 days after opening of academic session, whichever is later.
 - d) If a student joins the Institution, and leaves it in mid-session then the entire fees collected shall be forfeited.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admission to **85% open seats** of M. Sc. Nursing course will be made on the basis of merit of the **Entrance Test**.
2. Admission to **15% NRI seats** will be advertised separately. The candidates for NRI seats are not required to appear in the Entrance Test.
3. A candidate seeking admission to the **M. Sc (Nursing)** course is required to send his or her application on the prescribed form appended at the end of this prospectus.
4. Before filling up the Application Form, the candidate is required to **go through the prospectus** carefully and acquaint himself/herself with all the requirements with regard to the filling-in of the Application Form and check his/her eligibility.
5. Application Form should be filled-in in **English** only.
6. The candidate shall fill-in the Application Form in his/her own handwriting in block letters written **neatly** and **legibly** with ink within the prescribed boxes.
7. Overwriting/cutting/erasing in the Application Form may lead to rejection of the Application and should be avoided. Any error arising on this account shall be the responsibility of the candidate.

8. The candidate should write his/her **complete address** in the Application Form for further correspondence. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that he/she gives his/her correct address. The MM(DU) or the College shall not be held responsible for any delay or loss of any document/correspondence in transit or for an incorrect address given by the applicant.
9. Application Form duly completed must be accompanied by **one self-addressed stamped envelope** (10" × 5") with postal stamps of Rs. 40/- affixed on the envelope.
10. The **last date** for receipt of Application Forms, duly completed in all respects, is **20-06-2018 (upto 4 pm)**.
11. Candidate should write his/her **name, father's name and mother's name** in capital letters as given in his/her Matriculation/High School Certificate of the Board. Only one letter should be written in one box. One box should be left blank between each part of the name.
12. **Date of birth:** Enter the date, month and year of birth as per English calendar and as recorded in the High School/I.C.S.E./Class X or its equivalent certificate.

(Use numerals 01 to 31 for days, 01 to 12 for months and last two digits for the year of birth as shown below.)

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13. **Photograph:** Affix a recent (not taken before **01-01-2018**) high contrast photograph in the space earmarked for it on the Application Form. Accessories like caps, hats or dark spectacles are not permitted in the photograph. Polaroid camera photos are not acceptable. The photograph should not be defaced. The photograph should be firmly affixed to the Application Form with adhesive (gum/fevicol) and should not be pinned or stapled. The candidature of the candidate not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs is liable to be rejected.
14. Every candidate is required to submit only **One Application Form**. If a candidate submits more than one Application Form, his/her candidature against all the applications is liable to be cancelled.
15. Furnishing of false information or suppression of any information would disqualify the candidate from the admission/entrance test and cancellation of admission if already admitted. If considered necessary, legal action may also be taken against such a candidate in addition to forfeiture of the fee already paid.
16. The Application Form must be accompanied by the following **certificates/documents** duly **attested**:
 - a) **Matriculation** or equivalent Certificate (as proof of **date of birth**)
 - b) Certificate of **Qualifying Examination**.
 - c) Certificate of **Registered Nurse** and Registered Midwife
 - d) Certificate of **Work Experience**.
 - e) **Character Certificate** reporting on the inter personal/social behavioural pattern of the candidate issued by the Institution last attended by him/her.

- f) **SC/ST** Certificate having been issued not prior to **1.7. 2017** for claiming relaxation of 5% marks in eligibility for admission to M.Sc. Nursing.
- g) **Migration Certificate:** In case the Migration Certificate is not readily available, it may be submitted within 15 days of admission failing which the concerned student will not be allowed to attend the classes and his admission will be cancelled without any further notice and without any refund of fee paid by him/her.
- h) **Admit Cards** appended at the end of this Prospectus, duly filled-in **in triplicate** with a ticket size photograph on each.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. The Application form/prospectus once purchased will not be returnable.
2. The candidates must produce all the documents in original alongwith their attested copies at the time of counselling.
3. The Counselling Board shall have the power to call for any documents from the candidate in support of his/her claim and reject any certificate not considered valid.
4. The decision of the Counselling Board in this regard shall be final.
5. No judicial proceedings will lie against the competent authorities i.e. the MM(DU) for Counselling and Admissions.
6. All Admissions will be provisional i.e. subject to their final Registration by the MM(DU) after completing necessary requirements as per rules/Ordinance of the MM(DU).
7. Application Forms received after the due date and time due to any reason including delay in transit (Postal/Courier) will be rejected without any intimation to the candidates and no amount on this account including the amount sent as cost of Application form will be refunded in this behalf.
8. The selection for admission will be treated as cancelled even if the candidate has deposited the Admission Fee, if the selected candidate does not join the college on the stipulated date fixed by the Counselling Board.
9. If any candidate or his/her parents or guardian are found to have submitted any false document/affidavit/certificate or it is discovered that any portion of the information submitted by them is incorrect or false, not only the candidate's admission will be cancelled but the person submitting such information/document will also be liable to be prosecuted in accordance with Law in addition to forfeiture of the fees already paid by him/her.
10. The rules given herein are provisional. These may be changed or modified by the University at any stage.
11. Candidates who fail to attend the Medical Examination on the notified date(s) will forfeit the claim for admission and placement in the waiting list.
12. In case of any ambiguity in the rules, interpretation of the same as given by the Vice-Chancellor of this Deemed to be University shall be final.

REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING

- Regulations for **Elimination of Ragging shall be applicable** not only to the University and its institutions or any part thereof, including, **but not limited to**, the Departments, constituent units, Colleges, Centre of Studies and **all its premises**, whether academic, residential, playgrounds, or canteen, whether located **within the campus or outside**, and in **all means of transportation** of students, whether public or private, accessed by students for the pursuit of their studies in such institutions.
- **RAGGING constitutes one or more of any of the following acts :**
 - (a) **any conduct** by any student or students whether **by words spoken or written** or by **an act** which has the effect of **teasing**, treating or handling with **rudeness** a fresher or any other student;
 - (b) including in **rowdy** or **indisciplined** activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause **annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm** or to raise **fear** or **apprehension** thereof in any fresher or any other student;
 - (c) asking any student **to do any act** which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or **generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment** so as to adversely effect the **physique or psyche** of such fresher or any other student;
 - (d) **any act by a senior student** that prevents, **disrupts** or **disturbs** the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
 - (e) **exploiting** the services of a fresher or any other student for **completing the academic tasks** assigned to an individual or a group of students.
 - (f) any act of **financial extortion** or forcefully expenditure **burden** put on a fresher or any other student by students;
 - (g) any act of **physical abuse** including all variants of it: **sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health** or person;
 - (h) any act or **abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults** which would also include deriving **perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill** from actively or passively participating in the **discomfiture** to fresher or any other student;
 - (i) any act that affects the **mental health and self-confidence** of a fresher or any other student -
With or without an **intent to derive a sadistic pleasure** or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

- (j) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, casts, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional, origins, linguistic identity, place or birth, place of residence or economic background.
- Students are advised to Collect a copy each **Regulations of the UGC** and respective **Regulating Councils** on Curbing the Menace of **Ragging** from the office of the respective Institution of the MM(DU) at the time of admission.
