(During first week, students will work with individual chosen area of interest and will be held at four different locations in Denmark depending on theme. In second week all students will be together at the same campus close to Copenhagen will focus on the topics like Danish culture and the Nordic way of living and livelihood)

**Accommodation at boarding house:** Students will stay in shared rooms two and two with own bathroom. At the Boarding house, they will get three meals per day. All meals will be Indian style and with compliance to special diet requests like vegan/vegetarian food.
